This levy funds the RMC program so that contractors handling end-of-life refrigerant can effortlessly meet all applicable federal and provincial regulations. Not every refrigerant supplier chooses to submit this levy so ask your wholesaler who they purchase their refrigerant from and ensure that you are in fact supporting the **RIGHT** Wholesaler.
